1. REPLACEMENT: _____

“God sent Christ Jesus to take the punishment for our sins and to end all God's anger against us.”
Rom. 3:25 (LB)

“God took the sinless Christ and poured into him our sins. Then, in exchange, He poured God's goodness into us!” 2 Cor. 5:21 (LB)

2. REDEMPTION: _____

“He gave His life to purchase freedom for everyone.” 1 Tim. 2:6a (NLT)

3. RECONCILIATION: _____
