**4 HABITS OF HUMILITY**

1. PRACTICE PREFERENCE TO OTHERS.

*“Give preference to one another in honor.” Rom. 12:10 (NAS)*

*“Practice playing second fiddle.” (Mes)*

*“Don't push your way to the front... Put yourself aside, and help others get ahead. Don't be obsessed with getting your own advantage. Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. Think of yourselves the way Jesus thought of himself. He was God ... but He took on the status of a slave... an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, He lived a selfless, obedient life ...” Phil. 2:3-8 (Mes)*

*“Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.” James 1:19 (NIV)*

2. PRACTICE LEARNING FROM OTHERS

*“Conceited people do not like to be corrected and they never ask for advice.”*

*Pr. 15:12 (GN)*

*“If you reject criticism, you only harm yourself, but if you listen to correction, you grow in understanding.” Pr. 15:32 (NLT)*

*“Pride only leads to arguments.” Pr. 13:10 (NCV)*

*“Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.”*

3. PRACTICE ADDMITTING WHEN I'M WRONG

*“A man who refuses to admit his mistakes can never be successful. But if he confesses and forsakes them, he gets another chance.” Pr. 28:13 (LB)*

*“Make this your common practice: Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you can live together whole and healed.” James 5:16 (Mes)*

4. PRACTICE SURRENDERING MY PLANS TO GOD

*“God opposes everyone who is proud, but He gives grace to everyone who is humble. So surrender to God!” James 4:6-7 (CEV)*

*“Give yourselves to God ... and surrender your whole being to Him to be used for His righteous purposes.” Rom. 6:13 (GN)*

*“Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.” Matt. 11:29 (NIV)*
