- **The Tower of Babel** *Now the whole world had one language and a common speech. As men moved eastward, they found a plain in Shinar and settled there. They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar. Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, **so that we may make a name for ourselves** and not be scattered over the face of the whole earth." Gen 11:1-4 NIV*

- **The Call of Abram** *The Lord had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; **I will make your name great**, and you will be a blessing. Gen 12:1-2NIV*
